On July 13, we made an announcement that Al-Huda School and Hifzh School will continue remote learning during the first quarter of the school year and that a final decision for the second quarter will be made by October 15. After gathering information on the current COVID-19 situation, we noted the following:

1. Prince George's county remains to be the one with the highest COVID-19 cases in the state of Maryland, followed by the neighboring Montgomery county.
2. Public schools in Prince George's County as well the neighboring Montgomery and Howard counties are continuing online learning until the end of January.

In light of the above information, Al-Huda School and Hifzh School will continue online learning **at least until January 29, 2021**. As the situation evolves, we will make a decision for the remainder of the school year by January 15, 2021, In Shaa Allah.
